We are delighted to present the international educational path “Agón” Festival of knowledge and arts. The cultural project is dedicated to all passionate of the ancient greek culture, citizens and European high schools students with a linguistic, scientific, classical, artistic, sporting, musical, dance and touristic orientation.

Our recently established association of social promotion “European Festival of Ancient Greece” was born from the meeting of experts in non-formal education, artists and passionate of the history of Greek culture, in all its forms. The founding members are from different countries such as: France, Italy, Greece and Holland. Our initiatives are international in scope. The event will take place every year on October, March and April and will be attended by European schools, teachers and groups.

The association avails itself of the collaboration and support of national and international organizations of proven scientific value, such as: Euroclio (international organization of history educators), Agonfestival (International archeological film festival), the Lucanian section of the Italian Philosophical Society and the Prometheus Festival (technology and philosophy). All the proposed activities are supervised by a scientific committee of excellence composed of professionals of proven fame coordinated by the Professor Maristella Trombetta, professor of History of Aesthetics and History of Art Criticism at the Research and Innovation Department of the University of Bari, Italy

Our project for the promotion and enhancement of territories and human and cultural heritage aim to offer an opportunity for transversal learning and the development of concrete skills. All our initiatives are held in English language. Participation in our activities is free, with the exception of the registration fee to our association.

The “Agòn” project intends to recreate a historical path (from books to reality), a cultural network between the cities of Olympia, Delphi, Corinth, Nemea, Argos and Athens which hosted the artistic and sporting games in ancient times.

Thanks to the moral patronage of the directorates of cultural heritage, the municipalities and the collaboration with the schools of the places we visit, the event becomes of extremely importance in the field of active citizenship and peer education.

The artistic and literary contents that we propose refer to philosophical-anthropological studies and are closely linked to the disciplines of ancient Greece that still influence our *modus vivendi et operandi*. History, mythology, literature, archeology, ancient language, philosophy and science are the foundation of our activities.

Students and adults are the protagonists of our events, they actively participate in the development of documentaries related to digital historical-artistic dissemination as well as to artistic-creative activities which the aim is to "inspire" and to be a valid integrated support to the educational path of each participant.

Through initiatives that foster relationship and comparison in a European perspective, people participate in training activities with a free methodology (inductive method, cooperative learning, research-action), aimed at learning ethical values, such as: the centrality of the person, integration, inclusion, responsibility and active citizenship.

Our efforts, are today, in this historical moment, more than ever focused on the need to return to live experiences of value, relationships, sharing, awareness and well-being, which are essential aspects of our educational vision.

Our activities are designed to revive places of worship under a literary artistic light different from the classic and traditional trip to Greece.

The event is an opportunity to meet and confront with participants from different countries and cultures, to strengthen the identity of the European Community.

We consider these international meetings an occasion for growth for all participants and an opportunity that focuses on the person with its emotions and a tangible cultural exchange for all students.

**In short, the project:**

- supports and disseminates the research and historical culture of ancient Greece, the cradle of European civilization, of its art, through the great themes of history, literature, mythology, archeology, science and philosophy, to acquire consequently, the memory of the past, to orient oneself in the present and plan for the future.
- It promotes the social and cultural development of the territories, sustainable tourism, the enhancement of places of historical and archaeological interest.
- It aims to favor the propensity to ideation, to personal and cultural growth through a practical-creative approach, developing a method of thought and practice that goes deep into action, which allows you to look inside with greater awareness to lead at the realization of common projects with the construction of forms of cooperation.

- It favors a better knowledge of one's abilities, to act in a responsible, conscious and democratic way, to develop a cognitive process "learning to learn" that leads to know how to spread the knowledge of the artistic and cultural heritage of the territories, to support actions of cultural mediation, social inclusion, generational exchange, providing useful tools to develop concrete skills and orienting oneself in the future occupation.
